Eligibility:

All Saskatchewan residents ages 5 and older are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. All residents 18 years or older are eligible for a third dose, **4 months following their second dose.** All residents 70 years or older are eligible for fourth dose, **4 months following their third dose**
