The North Saskatchewan River Municipal Health Holdings held their regular meeting on Monday, September 21, 2020.

All physicians will be away from Oct. 13-16 to write The College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) Certification Exam. Locum coverage will be provided for this week, but appointment times are expected to be limited.

Physicians resumed regular scheduling on Sept. 8 and will no longer be cohorting to one facility only. NP Louise Ewen Peterson will only be working out of St. Walburg for the time being due to lack of office space for proper distancing in Turtleford. Resumption of in-person appointments for chronic disease management, SGI Medicals, PAPs and completes are underway. All other appointments requested will be required to book a phone appointment with the provider prior to being seen in person.
