### Eligibility:

All Saskatchewan residents born in 2009 (and older) are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. A second dose of the vaccine can be provided 28 days after receiving the first dose. All residents 65 years or older are eligible for a third dose,

**six months following their second dose.**
